- * **Dispensation from Friday abstinence.** For Catholics in the United States: prior to Vatican II, the Bishops of the country sought a dispensation from the normal Friday abstinence from meat on the Friday after Thanksgiving. The dispensation was granted by the Holy See and still stands to this day, as it has not been rescinded. One may in good conscience make use of this concession.
- * **The Season of Advent:** This year the first Sunday in Advent falls on November 29th - next Sunday. Advent devotions will be prayed after each Mass during the holy season.
- * **Bookstore** has Advent candles and calendars, as well as a good stock of Christmas items.
