Introit

Give peace, O Lord, to them that patiently wait for Thee, that Thy prophets may be found faithful: hear the prayers of Thy servant, and of Thy people Israel. –(Ps. 121. 1). I rejoiced at the things that were said to me; w shall go into the house of the Lord. V. Glory be...

Collect

Let the exercise of Thy compassion, we beseech Thee, O Lord, direct our hearts: for without Thee we are not able to please Thee. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, Thy Son, who liveth and reigneth...

Gradual
