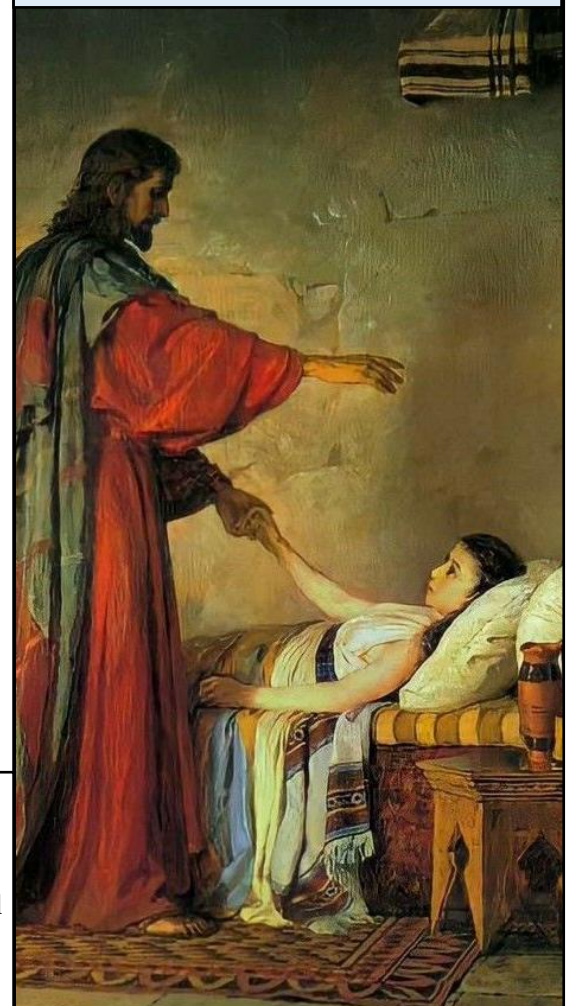
Mother dearest, Mother fairest,
