As soon as we have celebrated the Advent of the Holy Ghost, we celebrate in song the Feast of the Holy Trinity in the office of the following Sunday. This place is well chosen, for, immediately after the descent of this Divine Spirit, began the preaching and belief, and, through Baptism, faith and confession in the Name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost.

**Introit – Tobias 12. 6**

Blessed be the holy Trinity and undivided Unity: we will give glory to Him, because He hath shown His mercy to us. –(Ps. 8. 2). O Lord, our Lord, how wonderful is Thy Name in all the earth! *V.* Glory be...
