Last Sunday: Benediction after 9:30 AM Mass

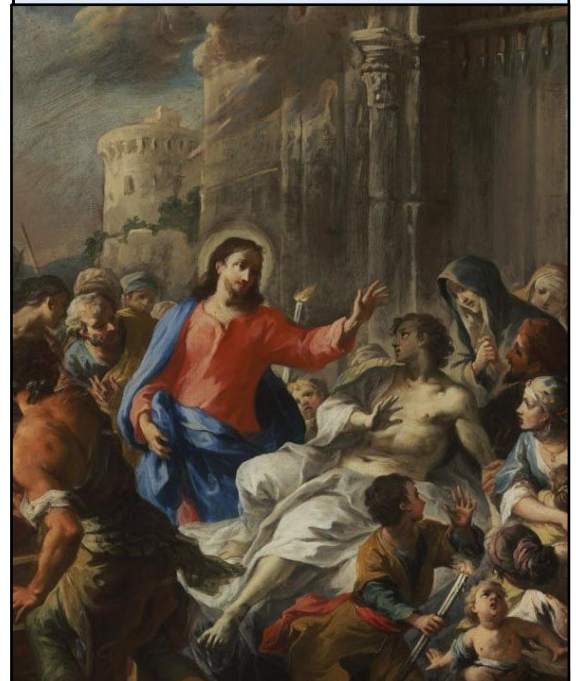
