#### Introit – Prov. 23. 24, 25

The father of the Just rejoiceth greatly, let Thy father and Thy mother be joyful, and let her rejoice that bore Thee. –(Ps. 83. 2,3). How lovely are Thy tabernacles, O Lord of Hosts! My soul longeth and fainteth for the courts of the Lord. *V.* Glory be...

#### Collect

O Lord Jesus Christ, who, being subject to Mary and Joseph, didst sanctify home life with unspeakable virtues: grant, that, by the aid of both, we may be taught by the example of Thy Holy Family, and attain to eternal fellowship with it: Who liveth and reigneth, with Thee in the unity of the Holy Ghost...

#### Gradual – Ps. 16. 4

One thing I have asked of the Lord, this will I seek after; that I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life. *V.* (Ps. 88.5).
